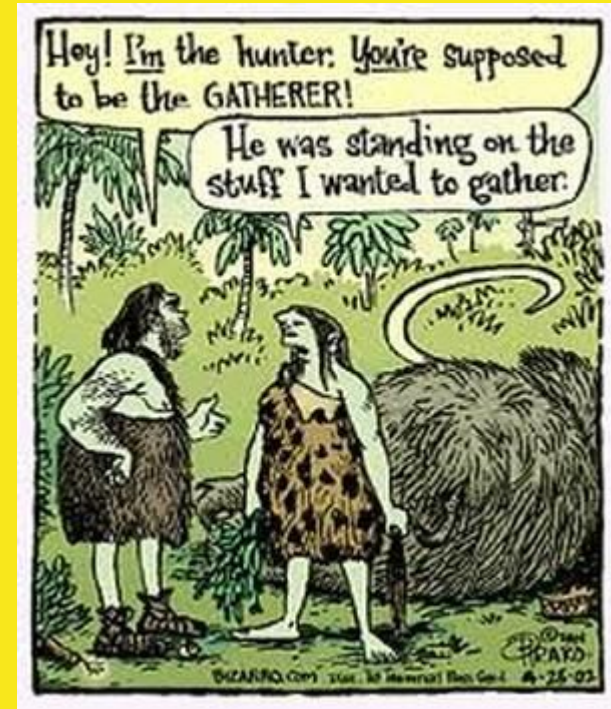
HOMINID

HUNTER-GATHERERS

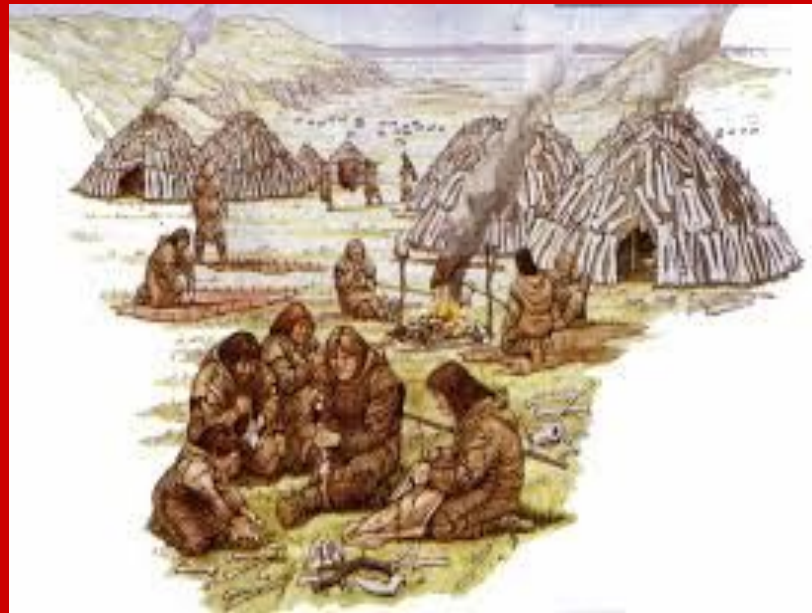
Early humans who hunt animals and gather wild plants, seeds, fruits, and nuts to survive.

NEOLITHIC ERA

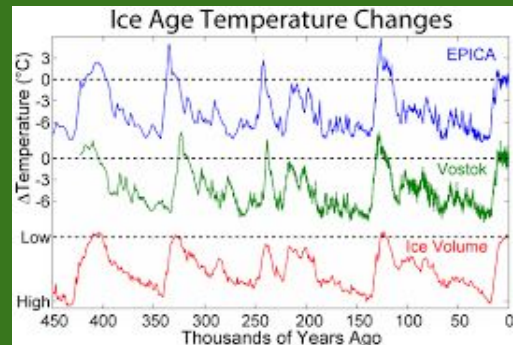
NEO= NEW

ICE AGE

A time of climate change when huge ice glaciers covered the Earth's surface allowing the early humans to travel over the frozen water to new land.



ARCHAEOLOGIST

A **scientist** who studies prehistoric people by analyzing artifacts, inscriptions, and monuments from the past



cave PAINTINGS

A FORM OF COMMUNICATION USED DURING A TIME OF NO SPOKEN LANGUAGE. USED TO TELL STORIES, PASS ALONG INFORMATION, OR TRACK ANIMALS.



LAND BRIDGE

A strip of land that connects two continents together that aren't normally connected
