

Religion

An <u>organized system of beliefs,</u> ceremonies, and rules used to <u>worship</u> a <u>god</u> or a <u>group of gods.</u>






Monotheism


The belief in <u>one god</u>.

*Ex. Christianity, Islam, and Judaism are monotheistic



Polytheism


The belief in many gods. *Ex. Mesopotamia and Egypt



Hinduism

A polytheistic religion. <u>India</u>'s 1st major religion. Believed to be the <u>first</u> religion known to mankind.






Buddhism

A <u>polytheistic</u> religion. Believers are called Buddhist. Follow the teachings of Siddhartha Gautama (<u>Buddha</u>).






Christianity

A <u>monotheistic</u> religion. Believers are called <u>Christians</u>. Believe in the teachings of <u>Jesus</u>.



Judaism

A <u>monotheistic</u> religion. Believers in Judaism are called Jews. Leader <u>Abraham</u> founded Judaism.









Islam

A <u>monotheistic</u> religion. Believers in Islam are called <u>Muslims</u>. Founder of Islam is <u>Muhammad</u>.





Deity

A higher power in a polytheistic * monotheistic religion.

For example a God or god/goddess.








Karma

Is the concept that every <u>action</u> has a <u>consequence</u>. The cycle of <u>cause</u> and <u>effect</u>.







How people treat you is their karma; how you react is yours.

Nirvana

A term to describe the profound <u>peace of mind</u>. It is the state of being <u>free from suffering</u>.







Siddhartha Gautama

A <u>prince</u> who turned to <u>meditation</u> to relieve suffering and reach <u>enlightenment</u>. He is now known as <u>buddha</u> [enlightened one].





Reincarnation
